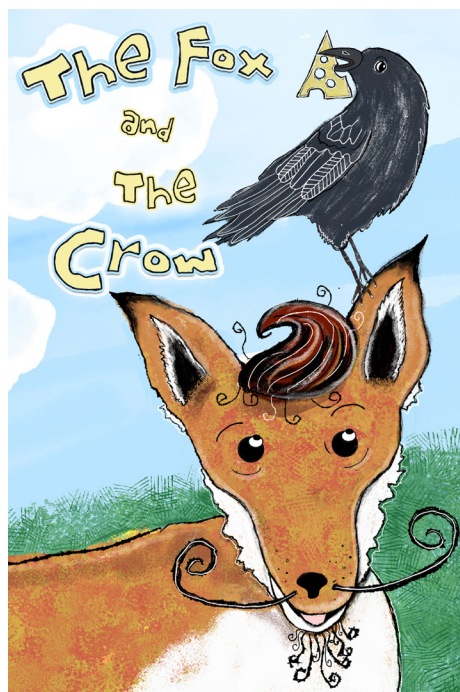


# Children's Book Illustration
